

# TULIP time again

The Tenant Users Liability Insurance Policy (TULIP) is offered by many WCIA members to the users of their venues and facilities. The TULIP insurance is written by Atlantic Specialty Insurance Company part of the OneBeacon Insurance Group (OneBeacon Entertainment). This program is an easy way for users to meet the insurance requirements for your venue. Users go online, select the appropriate member venue, and in a couple of minutes are able to get insurance. This year, OneBeacon Entertainment has added one change in the member administration of this program.

Members will still request new venues (locations) for the OneBeacon Entertainment website through WCIA. When making the request to WCIA, members will now have to include a copy of the rental/facility use agreement used at that venue. WCIA will need to furnish the agreement to OneBeacon Entertainment before they add the location to their website.

In other news, the TULIP rates will remain the same for 2018 as they were in 2017. Users can access the TULIP website either from WCIA's website at [wciapool.org](http://wciapool.org) or at OneBeacon Entertainment's website at [onebeaconentertainment.com](http://onebeaconentertainment.com). Please note that OneBeacon Entertainment updated their website a couple of years ago so make sure you are using one of the aforementioned links.
