

Prepare your drivers for the road by signing up for the online EverSafe Defensive Driving Course today

In the last five years, WCIA has paid close to \$17 million on Auto Liability claims and \$7.3 million for member vehicles. Driver training is one of the most effective tools in reducing auto accidents. WCIA partners with Evergreen Safety Council (ESC) to provide members the state-of-the-art *EverSafe Defensive Driving Course* at a discounted rate. This two-hour online, on-demand course is intended to ensure employees are confident in their knowledge of safe driving and can protect themselves from hazards on the road.

The training is recommended for new and seasoned employees who drive for your organization.

Topics covered include:

- Knowledge about your vehicle
- Rules of the road
- Skills for safe driving
- Attitude and habits

A certificate of completion is issued upon completing the course.

WCIA support:

- WCIA will pay for up to **10 registrations** per member entity. ESC will bill WCIA directly.
- Registrations exceeding **10** will be invoiced to your organization at \$25 per person (a reduced rate for WCIA members) by ESC.
