

Risk Management Training Allowance now available in Origami

Exciting news! The Risk Management Training Allowance (RMTA) program is now available through Origami. WCIA has allocated \$100,000 to the RMTA, which funds onsite training programs that reduce risk exposure, liability, and losses. The best part is that the RMTA is separate from your organization's annual Training Reimbursement Allotment and does not impact those funds.

Under the RMTA, members can select from a list of WCIA-vetted trainers on topics related to loss prevention and liability. The program is available on a first-come, first-served basis and allows for a training allowance of up to \$2,000 per member.

The allowance is paid after the training is completed and a request is submitted in Origami. Reimbursement requests must be submitted in [Origami](#) before 5 p.m. on **Friday, November 7, 2025**, unless funds run out earlier. WCIA will notify members if funds run out before the November 7 deadline.
