

New risk management training money available

Are you planning to implement anti-harassment training for your staff in 2025? Could your department benefit from a refresher in defensive driving skills?

The Risk Management Training Allowance (RMTA) can help subsidize your training expenses. The best part is that the RMTA is separate from your organization's annual Training Reimbursement Allotment and doesn't impact those funds.

Under the RMTA, members can select from a list of WCIA-vetted trainers on topics related to loss prevention and liability. WCIA has set aside \$100,000 for the RMTA. It is available on a first-come, first-served basis and allows for a training allowance of up to \$2,000 per member.

The allowance is paid after the training is completed and a request is submitted in Origami. Reimbursement requests must be submitted in [Origami](#) **before 5 p.m. on Friday, November 7, 2025**, unless funds run out earlier. WCIA will notify members if funds run out before the November 7 deadline.
