After sending out a Request for Proposal (RFP) in 2025 for a new online training provider, WCIA selected Cornerstone. This new platform is designed to streamline your learning experience by offering on-demand training and the ability to manage registrations for WCIA-hosted training in one place.

Key Date and Steps for Members to Take

- **Course Access Ends** - [WCIA Online Academy \(LocalGovU\)](#) will end at **11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2025**.
- **Course Completion Deadline** - Any courses assigned to your staff through the WCIA Online Academy will need to be completed before December 31, 2025. We recommend employees finish training earlier in the month to avoid last-minute issues.
- **Training History Reports** - Organization Administrator(s) should download training history reports from the WCIA Online Academy before December 31, 2025 to retain records for your organization.

What to Expect During the Transition

As WCIA moves over to Cornerstone, there will be a necessary period in which members will temporarily not have access to on-demand training. While the migration is underway, please note registration to WCIA-hosted training will still be available through Cvent.
